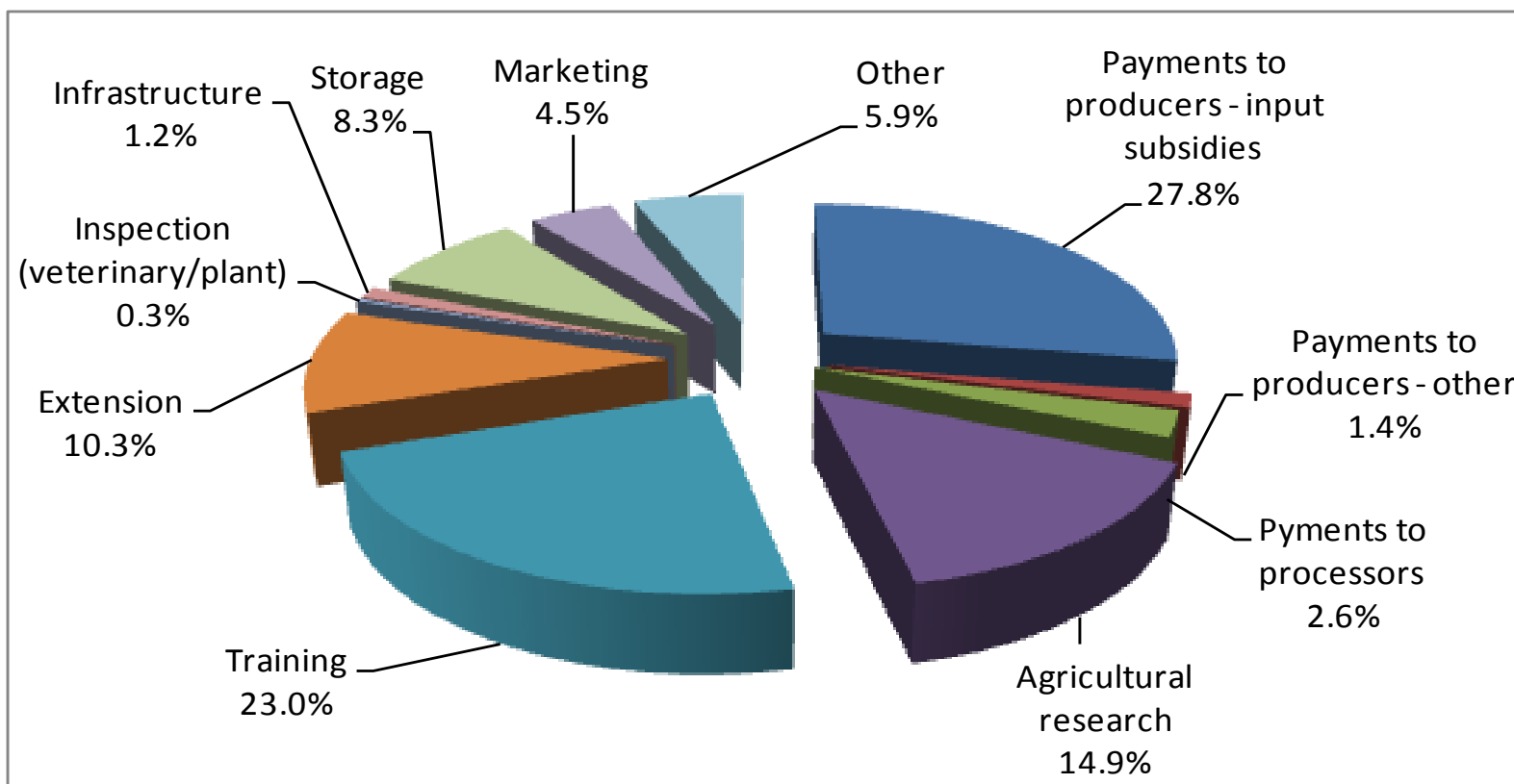

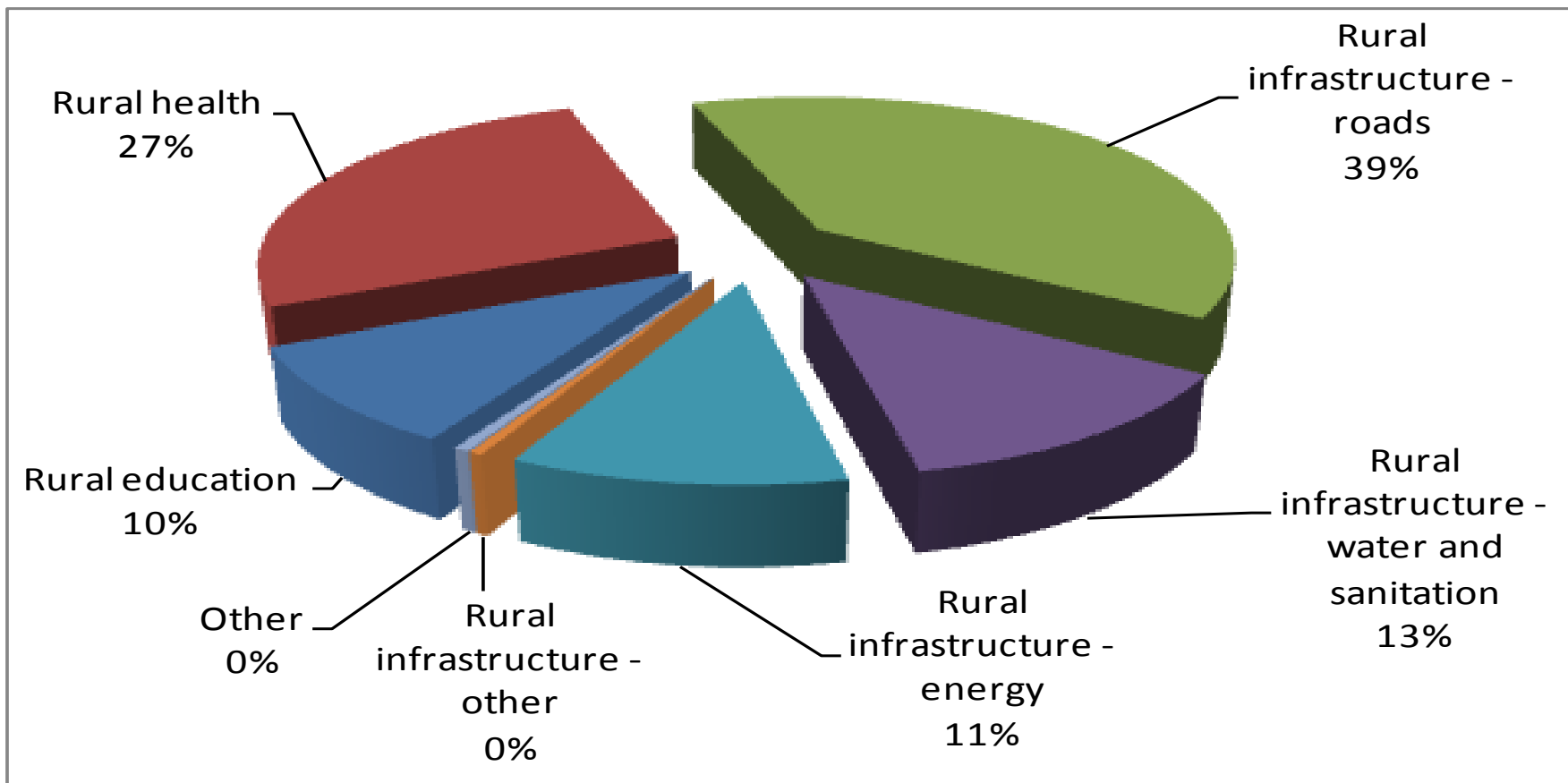

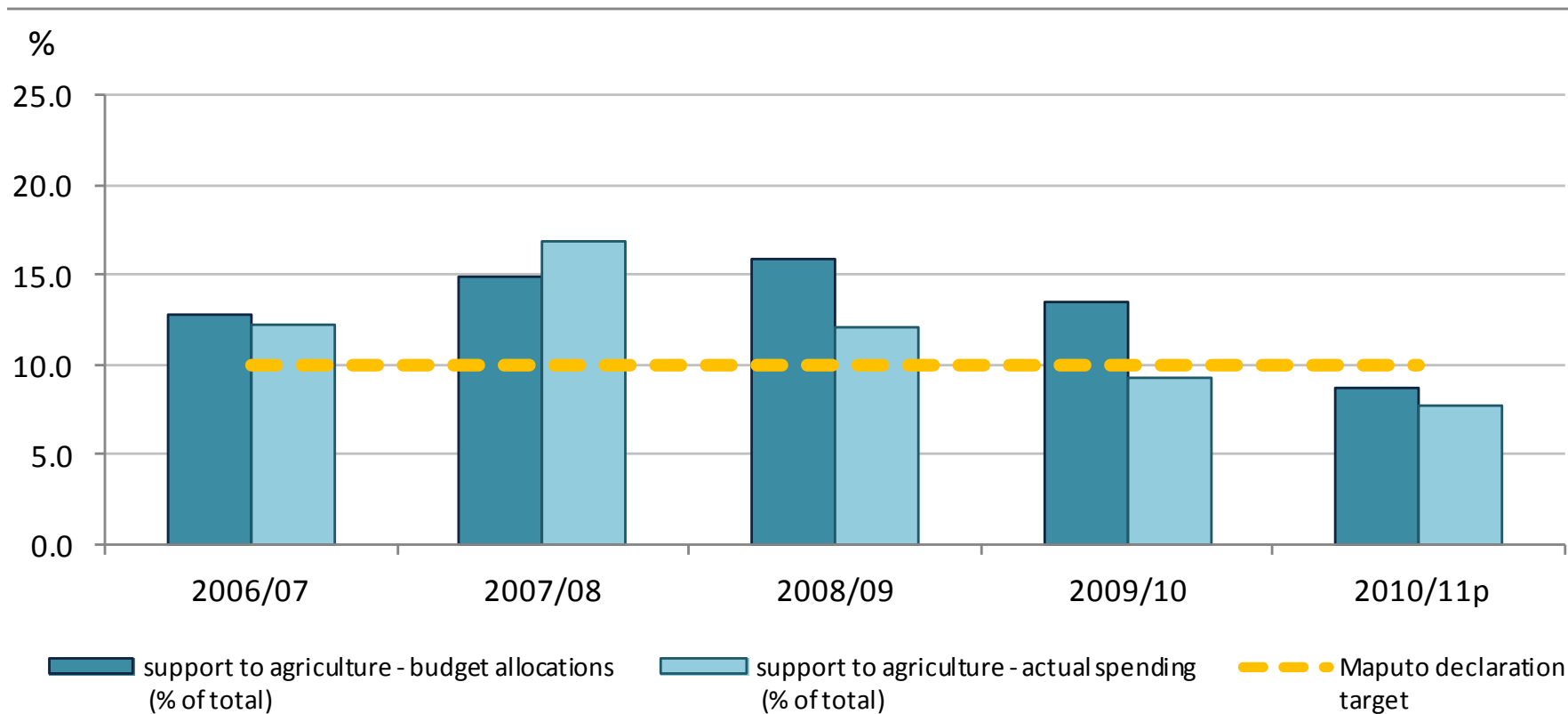

Investment Priority areas

- Infrastructure (feeder roads, markets, electrification, storage facilities etc.) and agro-processing
- Irrigation
- Mechanisation
- Research and development
- Farm inputs
- Renewable natural resources

Focus on Policy areas

- Need a sector Strategy (new ASDS)
- Define the Tanzania Farmer
- Agriculture services (research and extension)
- Land: tenure, use and management for agriculture
- Private sector-support to value addition
- Public Expenditure Reviews
- Agriculture Financing, marketing

Summary

- No major concern on budget
- Need to increase resource allocation to agriculture services (research and extension)
- Allocate resources to value addition and marketing infrastructure (storage and processing)
- Rural infrastructure
